Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- 1. I am setting up my e-grants account and it is asking for indirect cost. We have never set one up with any agency as we have not applied for state or federal grants. There is one that says 10% of MTDC. First what is MTDC and would this be the one that I choose. or say not applicable for all the questions.**

If you do not have, and never have had, a negotiated indirect cost rate, most organizations do not, then yes, you use the 10% de minimus rate. Here is more information on this:

De minimis rate of 10% of Modified Total Direct Costs – Any non-Federal entity that has never received a negotiated indirect cost rate, except for those non-Federal entities described in 2 C.F.R Appendix VII to Part 200—States and Local Government and Indian Tribe Indirect Cost Proposals, paragraph D.1.b, may elect to charge a de minimis rate of 10% of modified total direct costs (MTDC) which may be used indefinitely. (See 2 C.F.R. § 200.414(f))


