The AmeriCorps Volunteers in Service to America Program (VISTA)



- The only CNCS Program focused on fighting poverty.
- Started in 1965 as a "domestic Peace Corps."
- VISTA's are capacity builders...not staff members, community volunteers, or direct service providers.
- VISTA Projects seek to create or expand programs designed to bring individuals and communities out of poverty.
- Programs must focus on sustainability as VISTA resources are always temporary.



Requirements of VISTA Sponsors

- Cover costs of project operations including:
 - -Office space, computers, local travel, on-going training
- Recruit quality applicants;
- Develop **orientation** and training plans;
- Provide well-defined **position descriptions**;
- Track and report progress towards well-defined goals;
- Provide supervision and support to members;
- Ensure members do not displace staff or volunteers;
- Plan for **sustainability** beyond VISTA resources

 <u>Subject to FY17 appropriations</u>
- One-year award
- Programs will ideally support 3 or more members
- Programs that can cost-share are given preference
