AmeriCorps is a national service program in which people like you are making a powerful impact on the most critical issues facing our nation. AmeriCorps provides opportunities for more than 80,000 Americans each year to connect with others and get involved with their communities in a meaningful way — both here in Nevada and across the country.

AmeriCorps welcomes members of all abilities and backgrounds. You must be at least 17 and a legal resident of the United States. You can choose to serve full time or part time with national and local nonprofit and community groups.

Gain life and job skills — or share the skills you've earned — with AmeriCorps. Through this program, you'll have:

- An avenue to impact community needs,
- A living allowance during service, and
- An education award after your service year. If you are 55 or older, you can transfer this award to your child, grandchild, or foster child.
